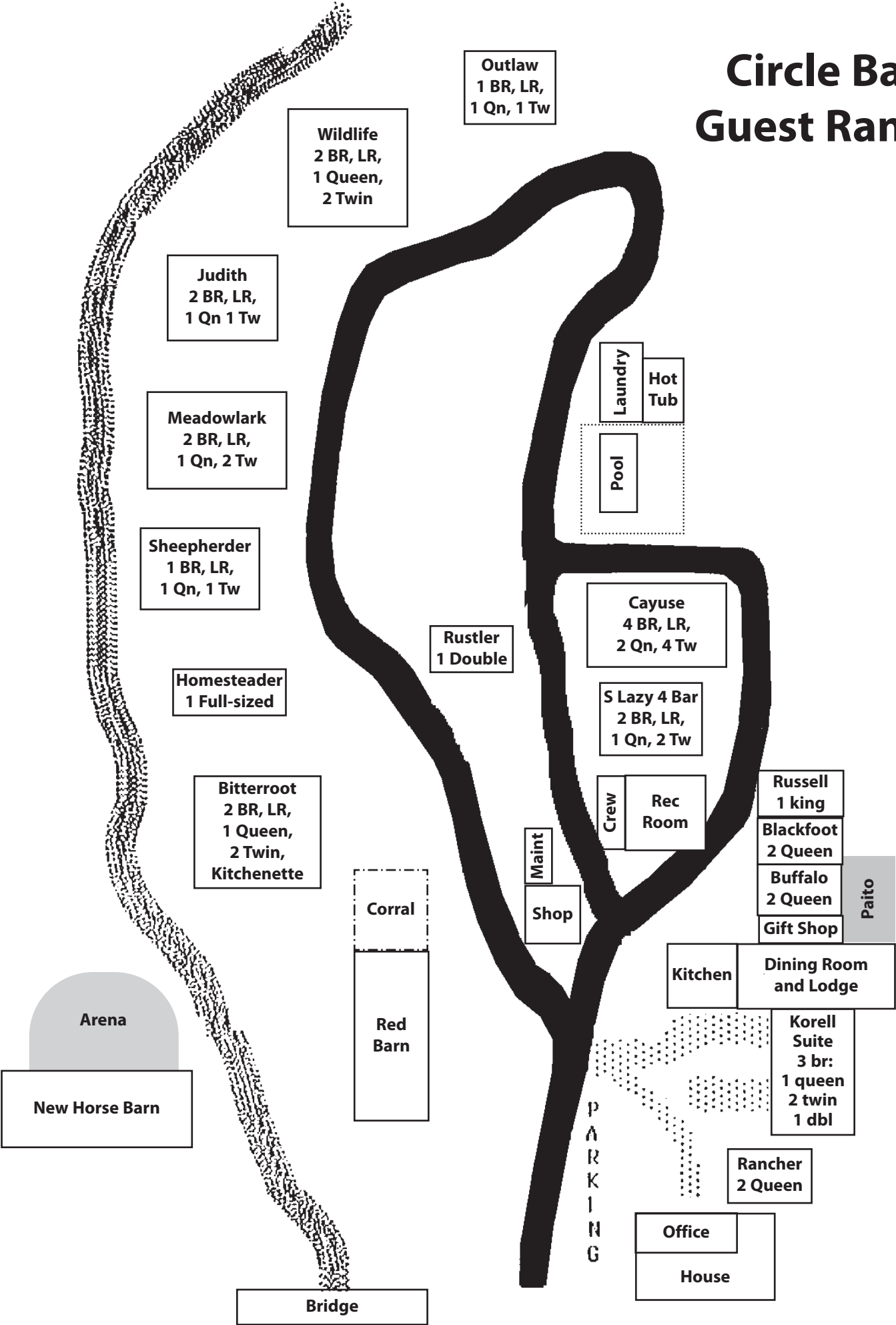

MAIN LODGE

We have three spacious and very comfortable rooms available in the Main Lodge – all three have private outside entrances and all three will put you “closer to the action”, footsteps away from dining, the Trading Post, Rec Room, pool and hot tub.

#1: THE BLACKFOOT: The land around us was once the hunting grounds of The Blackfoot Indians. This room is appointed with Native American décor and has a great view of the horse pasture and Korell Point. It has two queen beds and a private bath and shower.

#2 THE BUFFALO: This room is also large and very comfortable, with a buffalo theme. Artwork and décor trace the importance of this magnificent animal in Western culture. This room has two queen beds and a private bath and shower. It has access to #1, and could provide adjoining space for a larger group.

#3 THE RUSSELL ROOM: This is the Charlie Russell room. Prints from Montana’s most famous “Cowboy Artist” grace the walls in this large room with great views, a king-sized bed and a private bath and shower. This room is also handicapped accessible.

#4 THE KORELL SUITE: In honor of the family that started the guest ranch tradition here at the Circle Bar – the Korell Suite will accommodate a family or small group of friends – in the Main Lodge. It has one large bathroom with tub & shower – private laundry facilities – and a separate living room area. There are three bedrooms – one with two twin beds, one with a full-sized bed, and a third with one queen bed.

PRIVATE LOG CABINS

We have eleven of them – suited to a single, couple, family or large group of friends. We’ve modernized the original log structures, making them comfortable, while retaining their western charm. Most of them are built along the banks of the Judith River - all of our cabins rest under Montana’s Big Sky, close to the Main Lodge, Rec Room, Pool and Hot Tub.

S LAZY 4 BAR: A two-bedroom cabin that emulates the cowboy and a lifestyle that’s fast-becoming a rarity. S Lazy 4 Bar was the very first brand held by the men who first laid claim to the land here. A great view of the horse pastures and nearby mountains, a living room with fireplace, and two bedrooms – one with a queen bed, a second with two twins. Private bath with tub & shower.

CAYUSE: The Spanish word for “horse” – that’s the theme for this cabin. They are as part of the West as the cowboys and cowgirls that ride them! This cabin’s our largest, with four bedrooms (two with two queen beds and two with two twin beds in each). Great views, a large living room with fireplace & private bath & shower.

OUTLAW: The Old West wouldn’t be the same without them – Jesse James, Kid Curry, Billy the Kid – they fill the history books and we resurrect their memories here. One single bed in the living room, and a separate bedroom with a queen bed. Private bath & shower.

WILDLIFE: Whitetail and mule deer, elk, moose, bobcats, antelope, mountain lions and a few black bear are all found here. We have bald and golden eagles, pheasant, grouse and several species of hawk. You’ll also see beavers, porcupines and badgers. This cabin’s got a living room with fireplace and two bedrooms – one with a queen bed, another with two twins. Private bath & shower.

MEADOWLARK: This cabin takes its name from Montana’s state bird. Watch the birds and enjoy a gorgeous Montana sunset from your wrap-around porch. This two bedroom cabin has one queen bed and two twins, plus a living room, and a private bath with tub and shower.

SHEEPHERDER: What came first – the cattle or the sheep – it’s a long-standing argument between shepherders and cattlemen in Montana. Both are important in western history – both have their place. This cabin’s got a living room with one twin bed, a very unusual “beehive” fireplace, and one bedroom with a queen-sized bed. Private bath with shower.

HOMESTEADER: They faced seemingly insurmountable odds in their efforts to settle the West – this cabin applauds their success. A large river-rock fireplace graces the living room in this cozy one-room cabin, complete with a full-sized bed and a private bath with shower.

BITTERROOT: Montana’s state flower is abundant in the blanket of wildflowers we enjoy every summer at the Circle Bar. This cabin is the only one with a kitchenette. It’s got a large living room with an antique wood stove and two bedrooms – one with a queen bed, one with two twins. Private bathroom with tub & shower.

THE JUDITH: This two-bedroom cabin is named for the beautiful Judith River that runs for a mile through the Circle Bar Ranch. The cabin has one bedroom with a queen-sized bed and a second with one twin bed. Private bathroom with tub & shower.

THE RANCHER: The Judith Basin is dotted with large cattle operations and ranching remains the backbone of central Montana’s livelihood. This newly-renovated, large, one-room cabin is closest to the Lodge, has a private bath & shower, a large sunken fireplace and living room area, and two queen beds.

RUSTLER: This very cozy one-room cabin is being remodeled and probably will not be available for the 2010 season.
